



# MiG Prize 2022

The Michel Gelrubin Architecture Prize is designed to bring out new talents by giving students opportunities for international recognition. Founded in 2013, the Prize is awarded annually to honor students whose work demonstrates a combination of vision and talent in the art of architecture.

The recipient of the 1<sup>st</sup> prize receives a certificate, \$5,000 and an international recognition for his future career. The 2<sup>nd</sup> price receive \$2,500, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize \$1,500, plus a special certificate.

Any enrolled student (or group of students) may participate, regardless of their age, gender, nationality, or religion. Every year, an exceptional jury composed of 5 to 10 recognized experts in the fields of architecture, design, culture, construction, business or journalism, participates in the presentation of pre-selected projects, and deliberates early May before nominating the winner during the Tel Aviv University Board of Governors.

## This year's challenge: Extending architecture

The current imperative in cultural production challenges architecture to cross its disciplinarian boundaries by forming a dialogue with different cultural media and fields of knowledge. The MiG Prize will awarded to projects that extend architecture to unfamiliar domains, and in that process, redefine the status of architecture, its forms, materiality and performance. The project must have a strong thesis that explains both the motivation for interdisciplinarity and how it enriches architecture and its social and cultural scope.

### **Rules for submission:**

#### Format

Two **A0** posters in **pdf** format, presenting the project's concept and design, including project plans, sections, elevations, renderings, images, diagrams, and text.

A video (up to 3 min.) explaining the project. The video must be uploaded to Youtube or Vimeo. Make sure the uploader's identity is not disclosed.
